IN MEMORIAM

Since we have had new members join our Club over the last few years, most if not all do not know Kathi Kowalski, who has been unable to be very active recently. We thought it might be nice for you to know something about her and her family, since we have spoken and written about her during this last month. Kathi is a long time active member and past president of our Club. She and her family have been residents of Fairview Park for a long time, and active in St. Angela's and the greater Cleveland community. She and her husband, Mike Meissner, had two girls and a boy, Laura, Bethany, and Chris. Kathi and Mike had met at Harvard Law School, and while Mike continued in law, Kathi more recently concentrated on a journalism career. But her legal expertise has been very helpful to our Club over the years, as we applied for non-profit status, changed our name and incorporation with the State of Ohio from Junior Women's, and rewriting By-laws, just to name a few.

Mike spent much time with local non-profits such as Model United Nations, Rainey Institute, and I believe Cleveland Indians Charities, to name a few.

A while back, Bethany was diagnosed with a rare uterine cancer. She was living in Silver Spring, Maryland, and engaged to a young man named Jarrod. From the start, Beth met her diagnosis with fierce determination and grace. She continued to write beautifully, advocate for others, and give of herself to family, friends and community.

One weekend in May of 2016, Kathi was in Maryland participating in a fundraiser for a cancer fund with Beth. Mike stayed home to work, but passed away very suddenly and unexpectedly, of course devastating this lovely family. The outpouring from all of Cleveland was huge. Because Kathi did not need any assistance with food or other items, our Club members donated cash to be used as we saw a need. We first donated \$100 to the Rainey Institute in Mike's memory, an organization that promotes the Arts in innercity children and to which Mike was extremely dedicated. The remainder was given to Beth and Jarrod to help with expenses like parking at Johns Hopkins and other expenses during her treatments that are not covered by insurance.

Bethany and Jarrod did marry while Mike was still alive and had a belated honeymoon, all while she still battled cancer. There were times when it seemed like treatments might work, but nothing was permanent. Yet Beth continued to think of others more than herself, including asking for her birthday that others donate to a fund that supports children with cancer with funds for college. Sadly, she lost the battle on October 7, the day before her birthday. But she has inspired many, as shown by the amounts donated to that fund alone. A memorial service was held in Silver Springs on the 20th.

So once again, we would like to honor the Kowalski-Meissner family, and thus the request if you feel inclined. Regardless, now you know a little more about one special member and her family.
