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Our major fundraiser is almost upon us. Feb. 16th will be here before we know it. We, as well as the committees, are working hard to make this a successful and profitable event.

We are officially sold out! If you have not gotten your ticket(s), let me know. We will squeeze you in. Can't promise you a table of 8, but we'll get you in. We are starting a waiting list for all others.

We know we threw a lot of information out to you at the general meeting. Our next general meeting is after the event, so we wanted to make sure you have the info. If you have guests attending, please pass out your tickets in advance, if you are able. This will help at check-in.

If you have some spare time, please come to Nancy Cause's home on Monday, Feb. 11th at 7pm to help put the bags together. We have 240 bags to fill. We do it as an assembly line, so it goes rather quickly for so many bags.

Set up will begin on Friday, Feb. 15th, at 6:30pm. We will need help unloading cars. If any of your hubbies can spare a few minutes, that would be great. Some of these boxes can be heavy. We try to bring things in through the patio doors in the front of the building.

Saturday morning set up will begin at 9:00. The more help we have the faster we can finish and go home to relax before coming back for the evening. We had sign up sheets at the general meeting. If you did not get a chance to sign up, contact Sally or Nancy C, or the food committee chairs, Rosanne Kelley and Patty Beard.

At this time, we need help one more person to hand out bags at check-in, one person to work the 50/50 raffle board at the 1st shift (6:30-7:30), and one person for the 2nd shift (7:30-8:30). Sometimes we do more boards, we will just play it by ear. We also need a few people to pull sheets off the auction tables at the end of the auction. The more we have, the less chance of someone coming in and putting a bid in after it is called. There is an opening for one more person to be a Runner at the end of the night. This is where you put the winner's items back in boxes (if it came in a box), and bring it to the winner.

And of course, we need help with cleaning up. Everyone should be able to help with this. We will pull off the table numbers and anything else we think we need to keep, and then all else goes in the garbage. The kitchen needs help with clean up as well. We only have 1 hour after the event to get out of there. If we only have a few people helping, it takes a lot of time. They are so generous to us to allow us to come in on Friday night to set up, as well as the whole day on Saturday, so we don't want to take advantage of them and take our time getting out of there. Our goal is to be out within that hour, so be out on or before 11:00pm. Make sure you let your guests know that we have to clean up fast, so unfortunately, we cannot have them hang around too long after the event is over.

What should you wear that night? It's a Hawaiian Luau theme. IF you have anything with a floral print, please wear it. We are not asking you to go out and buy anything. Dig through your summerwear if you think you might have something. White pants, or capris, flip flops or sandals if you want. We know it's winter. Bring them up and change in the ladies room. And if not, that's fine.

We will need everyone back up to the Gemini Center by 6:00pm on Saturday night. There will be boxes of glasses to put in the hallway so we can get ready for check-in, food items and water pitchers to go on each table, etc. We want to be all ready when the first guest comes through the door. Our wineries will be

arriving no later than 6:00. Please remind your guests that doors open at 6:30, but no wine will be served until 7:00pm. They can check out the auction, buy raffle tickets, and play the 50/50 boards, or just sit and read the booklets they will be receiving with the auction rules and descriptions of the items. That 1/2 hour goes fast. The sooner we get everyone checked in, the sooner we can get started. Make sure your guests are not running late.
